

Inclement Weather Policy

We seek to have the church Sanctuary open for worship every Sunday, regardless of weather conditions. In case of inclement weather, the early service and church school classes may be cancelled. We plan to hold 11:00 a.m. Sunday worship, with rare exceptions.

However, if driving conditions are dangerous or walking is hazardous, do not come to church. Our commitment is to have a pastor at church for worship each Sunday morning, if possible, but we are not committing to have ushers, choir members or any other members involved in Sunday morning activities present. We are also not able to promise in all conditions to have walks shoveled or parking lots cleared.

Other meetings and programs other than worship services may be cancelled at anytime during the week if weather conditions become unfavorable. Chairs of committees should communicate with committee members if meetings are cancelled or postponed. The church office may close when weather conditions present a danger for travel.

Staying informed in times of inclement weather: We will keep our telephone voicemail up to date unless the telephones are not operating (call 467-4944). We also seek to keep our church website up to date and to notify television stations WRAL and WTVD. Our Building and Grounds Committee will respond to the need to shovel snow and clear parking lots as soon as possible.
